The Philalethes Society was founded on October 1, 1928, by a group of Masonic Students. The name of the Society is derived from two Greek words, *philos* and *alethes* which translates “lover of truth”. The Western Reserve Chapter was chartered in 1975. It was founded on the principle that there are Freemasons desirous of seeking and spreading Masonic light to anyone seeking truth. Today the Society has members within 185 Regular Grand Lodges.

At our meetings we exchange ideas, research current issues and problems confronting Freemasonry and pass them along to the Masonic world.

Every Master Mason in good standing can become a member of the Western Reserve Chapter. Our Chapter meets four times a year, twice on the east side of Cleveland and twice on the west side. There is a presentation of a new Masonic research paper at every meeting. Discussion and fellowship is encouraged.
